

VETERAN SUICIDE PREVENTION

The number of Veteran deaths by suicide exceeds 6,300 annually. 1.5 times the rate of non-veterans. That's 17-20 veterans every day. Suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death for 10-34 year-olds in the US.

Warning signs: Grief, anxiety, mood swings, hopelessness, sleep problems, giving away possessions, increased use of alcohol or drugs. Those with PTSD are more likely to have suicidal thoughts.

Prevention: Get out of the house, be it parks, malls, a library, anywhere in public, just so you're not alone. Talk to a friend or family member or someone who can get you through your feelings of hopelessness or desperation. Remember you can call 911 or the Veterans Crisis Line:

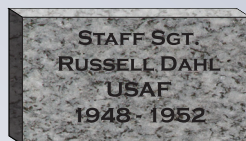
The Park Association has received a grant from Thrivent to pay for the printing and mailing of this newsletter.

Recently we purchased a large handicapped Porta Potty from D&J's Portables in Wadena. They will continue to maintain it for us.

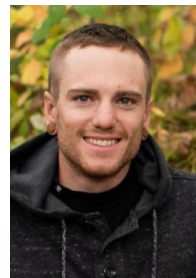
GRANITE PAVERS

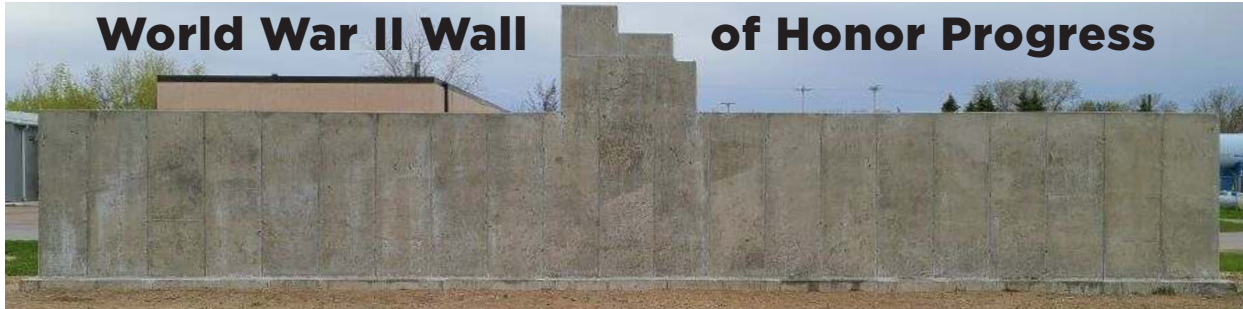

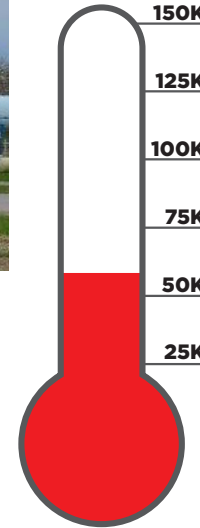
