WW II "WALL of HONOR" starts this year

The original wood sign was located on the corner of 1st avenue and 4th street during the War. The sign had over 900 names of men and women who served World War II. At the center was a neon lit US flag. The new sign, made of granite is expected to cost over \$90,000. The sign will be built in three phases; first the concrete interior and foundation, then the engraved panels and finally the lighted flag and back side of the monument. So far we have \$18,300 donated towards the project.



HISTORY OF THE VIETNAM WALL

58,267 names of U.S. fatalities are engraved on polished black granite of the Vietnam Memorial Wall.

- There are three sets of fathers and sons on the wall
- The largest age group, 33,108 were just 18 years old
- 997 soldiers were killed on their 1st day and 1,448 on what would been their last day.
- 244 were awarded the Medal of Honor, 153 of them are on the wall.
- The most casualty deaths for single month was May 1968 2,415.

The names on the wall are never forgotten. We honor and remember their sacrifice. "There are no noble wars, just noble warriors"
